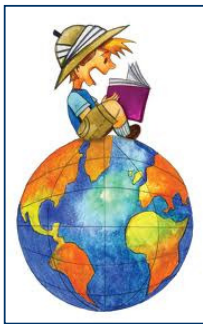




Library Competition 2012
